3) **PUBLIC SESSION**

The following issues were raised in the public session:-

- Planning application P/2019/01342 - Continued use of part of farmyard for dog breeding and training (Class Sui Generis), retention of kennels and erection of a whelping shed and store, Smithy Farm, Mill Lane, Gratwich, ST14 8SE
